

PROHIBITED ITEMS

Please take the time to familiarize yourself with this list of prohibited items. These items will be strictly enforced and may be confiscated.

- Bags larger than a small purse (6" x 6"h) including carrying cases, backpacks, camera bags or chair bags
- Clear plastic, vinyl or other carry items larger than 12" x 6" x 12"
- Plastic, metal or glass cups, cans or containers of any kind except for medical or infant needs
- Computers, laptops, radios or TVs
- Fireworks or laser pointers
- Low or oversize chairs, seat cushions or bicycles
- Seat cushions in a carrying case or that have pockets or compartments
- Pets, except for service animals
- Knives, firearms or weapons of any nature
- Video cameras (all weekend)
- Cameras (during competition rounds)
- Beverages (patrons may not bring in or exit with beverages) or coolers
- Posters, signs or banners
- Sports memorabilia or collectibles including baseballs, baseball bats, basketballs, footballs or hockey pucks
- Sports jerseys (exception: one jersey per spectator, must be worn)

PERMITTED ITEMS

- Opaque bags 6" x 6" or smaller
- Clear plastic, vinyl or other carry items not exceeding 12" x 6" x 12"
- One-gallon clear resealable plastic bag
- At the tournaments discretion, food may enter the tournament in a clear plastic bag not to exceed the size of a one-gallon clear resealable plastic bag
- Mobile phones, tablets and PDAs – must be on silent mode and adhere to TOUR's mobile device policy (www.pgatour.com/company/mobile-device-policy.html)
- Still camera with lens smaller than 6", no case (during practice rounds only)
- Umbrellas without sleeve
- Portable radios with headsets
- Medically necessary supplies, strollers, small diaper bags, plastic baby bottles and other necessary baby supplies (infant must be with carrier) – items subject to search
- Collapsible chairs without chair bags
- Binoculars without case
- Seat cushions that do not require a carrying case or that do not have pockets or compartments
