Parking

Friday June 24

Athlete registration takes place Friday June 24, 12pm – 8pm. Parking areas adjacent to the pedestrian village may experience high volumes of traffic. Please note that to increase the number of available parking spaces during the event, employees and guests are requested to leave P1 parking lot no later than 4:30pm, Friday June 24. Please plan extra travel time and on arrival, follow special signage directing you towards available parking lots (P2, P6 or P3).

Saturday June 25 – Event Day | Subaru IRONMAN 5i50 Mont-Tremblant

The resort's peripheral parking areas are open. Due to a high number of visitors, Service de police de la Ville de Mont-Tremblant will be setting up road blocks from 4:00am to 1:00pm. Please plan extra travel time and on arrival, follow special signage directing you to available parking lots (P1, P2, P3, P6 or P102).

Sunday, June 26 – Event Day | Subaru IRONMAN 70.3 Mont-Tremblant

Please park your vehicle at Wheeler Airport (across from La Belle Golf Course, a.k.a. Gray Rocks Airport) via Rang 8. **No other parking area will be open Sunday.** Shuttles offer uninterrupted two-way service between the resort and Wheeler Airport from 5am, Sunday June 26 until 10:00pm. The resort shuttle drop-off is located at the Chemin des Quatre-Sommets & Chemin Duplessis intersection; the return shuttle to Wheeler Airport can be boarded on the corner of Chemin Curé-Deslauriers & Chemin Duplessis.

Please note that Parking P101 (Club Intrawest) will be closed.

Parking P4X

Parking P4X will be closed from midnight, Wednesday June 22 until noon, Tuesday June 28. Permit holders should use Parking P2.

Public Transit

To make travelling about easier, we advise using free municipal transit on Sunday June 26.

Domaine Shuttle & Parking Shuttle

Temporary changes in effect:

Chemin Des Voyageurs will be closed from P2 parking area to Chemin du Curé-Deslauriers from 9am, Tuesday June 21 until 5pm, Monday June 27. However, it will be open to local traffic only between P2 parking area & Chemin Au Pied-De-la Montagne. Domaines & parking area shuttle stops are moved to P2 parking area for the duration of the closure, or from June 21–27 inclusively.

- 7:00am 12:30pm, Saturday June 25 Interruption of Transit Service
- 5:00am, Sunday June 26 to 1:00am, Monday June 27:

 - o Boarding (to Wheeler Airport): Corner of Chemins Curé-Deslauriers & Duplessis.

Shuttle Bus (Municipal)

9am, Tuesday June 21 to 5:00pm, Monday June 27 – Bus Stop Moved to Corner of Chemins du Curé-Deslauriers & Des Voyageurs.

Shuttles to Montréal & Mont-Laurier

Stop is located at the Shell gas station in Saint-Jovite. Resort transfers are ensured by the Municipal Shuttle.

- June 25 & 26: It is highly advised to use municipal transit

Lodging Guests Teeing Off at Tremblant Golf Courses

To make their reserved tee-off time, golfers should allow themselves extra travel time.

- Saturday June 25 Golf courses Le Géant & Le Diable are open from 7:00am until 12:00pm. Golfers lodging at the resort must use the shuttle that stops on the corner of Chemin Curé-Deslauriers & Chemin Duplessis.
- Sunday June 26 Golf course Le Diable is open whereas Le Géant is closed. From 7:00am to 5:00pm, golfers lodging at the resort must take the shuttle on the corner of Chemins du Curé-Deslauriers & Duplessis; on its way back to the resort from the Airport, it will drop them off at the golf course.
